

### Chronicle Table of the Japanese Society of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition (1/7)

Year	Activity
1927	Creation of the rules of the Society of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition on the 17 <sup>th</sup> June for issuing the Journal. This is the foundation of the society. The 1 <sup>st</sup> Japanese Journal of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition (Volume 1 No. 1, 158 p) was issued in October. Delegates were sent to the 1 <sup>st</sup> International Congress of Soil Science (ICSS, USA, Washington).
1930	The Association of Japanese Agricultural Scientific Society was established and the 1st Conference was held. The JSSSN organized the 1st symposium as the 10th division. Participation at the 2nd ICSS (USSR, Moscow, Leningrad).
1934	Issue the 4th Journal. The English name of the Journal from the 8th issue was set as Journal of the Science of Soil and Manure, Japan, the name of the society was set as The Society of the Science of Soil and Manure, Japan.
1935	Participation at the 3rd ICSS (England, Oxford).
1937	Establishment of the Kanto Branch, then Kansai, West-Japan, Korea and 満州 branches were established, which lasted till the end of the war. The journal was issued 6 times per year from Volume 11.
1939	The journal was issued 12 times per year from Volume 13.
1944	After the last society before the end of the war on the 11th December, the society was suspended.
1948	Due to the lost of documents during the war, the society started new again. Four branches were established; North-Japan, Kanto, Kansai and West-Japan. The Journal Volume 19 was published again, with 5 issues per year.
1949	The North-Japan branch was divided into Hokkaido and Tohoku branches, and the number of branches became 5. The Journal was issued 4 times per year
1953	Supporting membership was settled. Bimonthly publication of the Journal from the Volume 24.
1954	Introduced the Symposium method to the annual meeting. Participation at the 5th ICSS (Belgian Congo, Leopoldville).
1955	Change of the board election method. Setting of accounting audit. Created the award Soil Science and Plant Nutrition Society and awarded the 1st prize. Issue the Journal monthly from Volume 26. 1st Publication of the English Journal "Soil and Plant Food".
1956	The presentation at the annual meeting was separated into divisions. The English Journal was issued 4 times a year from Volume 2. Participation at the 6th ICSS (France, Paris).
1957	Reconstruction of the branches, which became from 5 to 6 till present. Publish the abstracts of the Japanese Journal in the English Journal from Volume 3.
1959	The number of the Society was 1,981, supporting member 61 companies. Publish reviews in the English Journal from Volume 5.
1960	Participation at the 7th ICSS (USA, Madison).

1961	Publish the English Journal bimonthly. The name of the Journal became “Soil Science and Plant Nutrition”.
1963	The spring meeting was held in Kyoto, and it was decided that the conference is held outside Tokyo each 2nd year. The Future Plan Committee addressed the “Problem concerning the education in soil science and plant nutrition”.
1964	Participation at the 8th ICSS (Rumania, Bucharest).
1966	Establishment of 10 division and division head system.
1968	Celebration of the 40th year anniversary (4th April). Participation at the 9th ICSS (Australia, Adelaide, 6th-16th August).
1969	Special issue on the 40th anniversary “Development of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition in Japan” was published. Short Communication was included in English Journal SSPN.
1971	The 11th division (Environmental protection) was established. The turn of annual meeting was decided.
1972	Establishment of council system. Student member was included to the membership types. The publication of the English Journal was entrusted to Center for Academic Publications Japan.
1973	The English Journal was issued 4 times from Volume 19.
1974	Participation at the 10th ICSS (USSR, Moscow, 12th – 20th August. The 11th ICSS was suggested to be in Japan, but it was turned down, and a international seminar was suggested.
1977	“International Seminar on Soil Environment and Fertility Management in Intensive Agriculture” (SEFMIA) by the ISSS was held. (Oversee participant 80, Japanese participant 230, Tokyo 10th -17th October).
1978	The society became an incorporated association Japanese Society of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition from 1st April. Issue the articles of incorporation. Celebration of the 50th year anniversary was conducted. The society became organized by board members. The office moved to Bunkyo-ku, Hongo 6-26-10-202 in May. Bimonthly publication of the Journal from Volueme 49 (1). Participation at the 11th ICSS (Canada, Edmonton, 19th -27th June). ISHIZUKA Yosiro was selected as the 1st honorary member of ISSS.
1981	The English name of the society was decided as “Japanese Society of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition (abbreviation JSSSPN).
1982	Committee to promote soil education was founded. The 1st Encouraging Prize of the Society of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition was awarded. Participation at the 12th ICSS (India, New Delhi, 8th 16th February).
1982	Committee to promote soil education was founded. The 1st Encouraging Prize of the Society of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition was awarded. Participation at the 12th ICSS (India, New Delhi, 8th 16th February).
1983	Publication of Society of “Terms of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition”.

1986	Publish the “Standard methods for soil analysis and measurement” edited by the society. Participation at the 13 <sup>th</sup> ICSS (West Germany, Hamburg, 13 <sup>th</sup> -20 <sup>th</sup> August).
1987	Exhibit the English Journal SSPN to the Frankfurt Book Fair (7 <sup>th</sup> -12 <sup>th</sup> October). Co organize with the USDA the 9 <sup>th</sup> International soil classification workshop “Characterization, classification and use of volcanic and paddy rice soil” in Japan (20 <sup>th</sup> July to 1 <sup>st</sup> August).
1988	Participation at the 5 <sup>th</sup> International Soil Conservation Conference (Thailand, Bangkok, 18 <sup>th</sup> 29 <sup>th</sup> January). Participation at the 1 <sup>st</sup> international Symposium coorganised by ISSS and Paddy Soil Fertility Working Group (Thailand, Chiang Mai), 6 <sup>th</sup> -13 <sup>th</sup> December).
1989	Organize “Present and future of fertilizer” as a satellite symposium of the 14 <sup>th</sup> ICSS (25 <sup>th</sup> -26 <sup>th</sup> September).
1990	Publish the “Analysis methods of plant nutrition” edited by the society. Organize the 14 <sup>th</sup> ICSS together with the Science Council of Japan in Kyoto (12 <sup>th</sup> -18 <sup>th</sup> August, participants 1,616, among them 761 foreigner from 75 countries). Establishment of preparation committee of East and Southeast Asia Federation of Soil Science Societies (15 <sup>th</sup> August). Organize an international Symposium “Rhizosphere and stress” (20 <sup>th</sup> August).
1991	Adapt the SI unit to the Japanese and English Journal, and declared the recommended examples including some non-SI units. Publish the “Organic savage use at green an farmlands” and “Current situation and measures of Japanese farmland soils” edited by the society. 1 <sup>st</sup> East and Southeast Asia Federation of Soil Science Societies (ESAFS) workshop “Comparison of farmland soil classifications in East and Southeast Asian countries” in Osaka (10 <sup>th</sup> -16 <sup>th</sup> October).
1992	Adapt SI unit in the Japanese Journal from the Volume 63 No. 1. ESAFS office moved to Chinese Soil Science Society from August.
1993	Participation at the 2 <sup>nd</sup> ESAFS workshop “Classification and management of desert soils” (China, Urumqi, 20 <sup>th</sup> - 23 <sup>th</sup> August).
1994	Committee of the Future Panning of the Society, and Committee of Financial problems were formed. Participation at the 15 <sup>th</sup> ICSS (Mexico, Acapulco, 10 <sup>th</sup> -16 <sup>th</sup> July). Participation at the 3 <sup>rd</sup> ESAFS workshop (Malaysia).
1995	Reorganize the society from 11 to 8 divisions and set the research unit to 24 groups. Start the Soil Science and Plant Nutrition Technology Award. Publish a supplemental book for elementary and junior high school teacher “Tales about soil for teachers”.
1996	Award the 1st Soil Science and Plant Nutrition Technology Award. Committee to deal with the English Journal was formed.

1998	Publish "Soil and Food – for a healthy future" as the anniversary of 70th anniversary (25th September). Publish "How to teach soil – a new environmental education material". Participation at the 16th WCSS (France, Montpellier, 20th-26th August), where the honorary member of our society WADA Koji was elected as honorary member of the ISSS. Due to the change from ISSS (International Society of Soil Science) to IUSS (International Union of Soil Sciences) that is a member of ICSU (International Council for Science), the conference name was changed from ICSS to WCSS (World Congress of Soil Science).
1999	Organize a 70th year anniversary symposium "Outlook of soil science and plant nutrition research in sustainable agriculture based on region" (3rd April). Open symposium "Soil pollution in Japan and its remediation" (4th June).
2000	Employ delegates system to the first general assembly. First delegate election in November. Donation from the member INAMATSU Katsuko and found the "Woman and young member support fund (Inamatsu Found)". Reedited the "Terms of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition (1983)" and publish "Terms of Soil Science, Fertilizer and Plant Nutrition".
2001	General assembly by the first delegates (3rd April). Participation at the 5th ESAFS international conference (Thailand, Krabi, 27th-31st May).
2002	Publish the "Picture book of Soil; 5 volumes". Organize the 2nd International Conference on "Silicate and Agriculture" in Tsuruoka (22nd-26th August). Participation at the 17th WCSS (Thailand, Bangkok, 14th-20th August, Participants 2,000, among them 120 Japanese).
